Working with Other Charities Policy

The basic principle to work on is that one charity (charity A) cannot donate money to another charity (charity B). Money raised by charity A must be used to meet the objectives of charity A, which will almost certainly be different from those of charity B. This may be an arguable principle, however the Trustees of charity A may be held personally liable for any miss-application of funds, so it is safest to adopt a policy of not donating to other charities.

This does not prevent Barnstaple Pilot Gig Club CIO from working with another charity in joint fund-raising events. The following conditions should be observed prior to any such event:

- 1 A proposal and vote on joint fund-raising events should be recorded in minutes of Committee or Trustee Meetings prior to the event taking place.
- 2 Members of both organisations should work together on the event.
- 3 The division of surplus income over expenditure between the two charities should be agreed prior to the event.
